## Publicizing events—do we want 400 flyers to go out for each event?

- Paper flyers about library events are widely distributed to departments (academic and non-academic staff) but not to individual faculty.
- LEC has opted out of sending these flyers in the recent past, and therefore we have no
  information on whether they increase turnout for LEC events.
- Per Theresa Moore, electronic distribution does not reach the same people that paper flyers can reach, and social media promotion doesn't reach people who aren't already following particular accounts.
- We are trying to reach a wider audience beyond the library, so wider distribution of news about LEC events is desirable.

- We will distribute flyers for the October Beal Garden Tour, to test whether they increase turnout relative to past tours.
